On Sunday, October 28, 2007 at approximately 0100 hours Yolo County Sheriff's Department units responded to a possible stabbing and shooting that had occurred near the intersection of Main and Stephens Streets, in Madison. Upon arrival our units discovered that the victim, Angel Barrera, age 41, of Woodland, had been stabbed multiple times.

The victim, Barrera, was transported by air ambulance to the UCD Medical Center for treatment. His condition is unknown at this time. The investigation is continuing.

It was discovered that there had been a party in the area and that multiple people were involved in a fight. Deputies initiated an investigation, which led to the arrest of Gilbert Puebla, age 19, of Madison, for assault with a deadly weapon.
