The Yolo County Sheriff's Department, Animal Services Section is attempting to locate a missing dog from the three car fatality collision in Woodland on Highway 113 and County Road 25A that occurred on February 28, 2011.

There were two Chow Chow dog's in one of the vehicles. The male Chow Chow dog was located and removed at the scene of the accident, but the second is still missing. The missing dog is a spayed female Chow Chow, tan and reddish brown in color and answers to the name of "Suzy". "Suzy" was seen after the accident to be in the N. Pioneer, Gibson Road and E. Main Street area. The dog was last observed on March 2, 2011 at 830 a.m. near Home Depot in Woodland.

The dog owner, who is from Fremont, is still in the hospital recovering from his injuries.
